Case # 17009194 had two vials sent to the Texas Department of Public Safety for testing. The Grinder in this case was found properly sealed and labeled in the property room.


Case # 17009042 the various evidence was found in the property room properly labeled and sealed

Case # 18001048 the shell casing was found in the property room properly labeled and sealed


Case # 180022235 the firearm was properly labeled and sealed in the property room.

The property room was found to be in satisfactory order.


