STANDING ORDER IN ALL CRIMINAL MISDEMEANOR CASES

On or before the date scheduled for the Defendant's pretrial hearing in all criminal misdemeanor cases now or hereafter pending in this Court, the State, through the office of its County Attorney, is ORDERED to produce and make available to the Defendant's Attorney at the office of said County Attorney for inspection and copying and without the necessity of the filing of a motion for discovery or production thereof the following:

The criminal arrest and conviction records (criminal history), if any, of the Defendant.

The purpose of this Order is to eliminate the necessity of pretrial hearings or the filing of pretrial motions related to the discovery of Defendant's criminal history. The discovery materials made available to defense counsel or a copy thereof may not be sent or otherwise provided in any matter to the defendant, the defendant's family, or any other person on the defendant's behalf. Defense counsel may show the defendant or others the discovery materials in the course of representing said defendant, but may not allow same to be copied.

This order is effective 20<sup>th</sup> of December, 2017, and shall remain in full force and effect until altered, modified, or rescinded by the Court. The Clerk of this Court shall cause a copy of this order to be filed in all criminal cases at the time that a complaint and information is filed by the clerk of this Court.
