

Pro-Se Divorce

Must not have any real property

Must not have children under the age of 18

1. Original and 2 copies of the Original Petition for Divorce signed by the Petitioner and attach the Standing Order to the original and (2) copies. The Standing order can be found on this web site (co.erath.tx.us – District Clerk)
2. The Standing Order Certificate acknowledging the Standing Order must be notarized
3. Waiver of Citation signed by the Respondent in front of a Notary
4. Court Testimony – 2 copies, one for the file and one for yourself (this is what you are going to say in front of the judge on the day of your final hearing)
5. Original and 2 copies of the Final Decree of Divorce signed by BOTH parties. The Decree needs to be worded to fit your situation, n/a is not acceptable
